The 2007 Chalice Bridge Semillon Sauvignon Blanc (\$16.95) from Rosa Glen in Margaret River's south scored Top 100 and Blue-Gold with its delightful aromatics and the 2007 Catching Thieves Rosé [a McWilliam's Margaret River label] scored Blue-Gold with its fresh garden-herb flavours.

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The 2005 Evans & Tate Shiraz (\$21.95) went Blue-Gold while a couple of weeks before its big brother, the 2005 Evans & Tate Reserve Shiraz (\$40), won a stunning six trophies at the Sydney Show.
