“Clairault manages to harmoniously set a sleek modern dining room in rustic bushland, cheek-by-jowl with a busy cellar door. The hardest thing about lunching here is getting a table. Albany rock oysters are a bit of a rarity and the opportunity to enjoy them needs to be taken when it arises; they’re perfect with a light vinaigrette. Nor-west scallops are visual and textural treat sitting on a disc of beetroot and a slice of chorizo. Margaret River venison comes as loin slices in an oxtail broth with crab ravioli. Sumac-rubbed lamb is fragrant, served in a bowl on a cassoulet of chick peas and sweet potato—and its sensational. The dessert selection is very small, which makes the Blue Cow cheese even more attractive. Clairault offers a good selection of its older wines at very good prices and nearly all the current range by the glass.”
